### EPIC ONLINE TRAINING MODULE

Mai Lee, of HSHS, shared the following updates.

- Can HSHS eLearning modules be used for non HSHS organizations? HSHS replied 'yes'; however, Epic's response was 'no'. Mai has a meeting with Epic on 6/22/2017 and will confirm with them, as all of the GGBHA students and faculty use Epic.
- Can HSHS eLearnings be hosted on the GGBHA website? HSHS did not foresee a problem with this. Mai will check with Epic on 6/22/2017 to confirm their response.
- Can the HSHS eLearnings be used as a refresher? Yes

More clarification is needed. HSHS eLearnings were going to be used to train faculty who then train students. Discussions progressed at the 4/14/2017 meeting into hosting the eLearnings for students. After review, some members feel this could not be a direct replacement for what the GGBHA is currently doing. It would take new students hours to get through the training. It could; however, serve as a refresher piece. Some of the instructors shared that the HSHS eLearnings they viewed were not interactive, allowing a student to turn on the module and walk away.

The 'Epic Access Request' GGBHA website form was reviewed and will continue to be used for its intended purpose.
