Resident Rotation Skill Level

- The Residency Program has identified which skills are applicable for each rotation.
- These skills have been shared with the resident within rotation objectives, outcomes, syllabus, etc.

Resident Rotation Skill Level

- The resident is aware of the specific skills they may perform with guidance during each rotation experience.
- Residents attest they will not perform skills that are out of the scope for each specific rotation.

Faculty Responsibility Related to Resident Rotation Skill Level

- A. The Residency Program has identified which rotation skills are applicable for each course.
- B. Faculty are aware of the specific skills residents may perform with guidance during each rotation.
- C. Faculty attest they will not have residents perform skills that are out of the scope for each specific rotation.

Faculty Responsibility Related to Resident Rotation Skill Level

At the beginning of each rotation day, faculty will provide the rotation area a list of skills the residents have been taught that are within the scope of this rotation experience.
